

WHEN AND WHERE DO THEY MEET???

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST???

In order to cover the cost of activities and to extend and replace resources, a small fee is charged.

At the same time, the group aims to support parents and carers in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere. With this in mind, North-East Playtime adopts a balanced philosophy which includes structured child-centred activities, adult-directed programs and free and purposeful play.

Being a church ministry, there will be included from time to time Bible related stories, crafts and songs in Playtime.

Parents and carers can also expect to receive a weekly devotion from the
